

2026-2027 PBL Education Foundation Staff Grants

The PBL Education Foundation (PBLEF) is excited to offer grants this year to innovative teachers! Educators PreK-12 are eligible to receive up to \$1,000 per staff member. You may apply for an individual grant or collaborate with other teachers for a larger grant!

Grant requests must:

- ★ Align with and enhance the regular curriculum - be creative!
- ★ Be a resource, material, program and/or activity that the district is unable to fund.

If you receive a grant, you **MUST** provide PBLEF:

- ★ Photos showing students engaged in learning using the resources provided through the grant.
- ★ A written statement telling how the grant impacted student learning and/or statements from students.

You **MUST** also:

- ★ Mention PBLEF in ALL Facebook posts, notes to parents, signage, printed programs, public events, etc. to help promote PBLEF!

Please be prepared to provide the following information on your grant application.

- ★ Project Title
- ★ Staff - Name, Grade Level/Department, Email (for each staff applying)
- ★ Number of Students that will be impacted by the grant
- ★ Description of proposed program/activity - including goal
- ★ Detailed, itemized budget
- ★ Principal's Acknowledgement that building/district funds are not available

Timeline

- ★ **August 17, 2026** - online application submission will **open** at:

- ★ You will receive an email verifying your submission.
- ★ **September 30, 2026** - online application submission will **close**.
- ★ October 16, 2026 - PBLEF will send an email notification letting you know whether or not your application was approved. If approved, you may begin purchasing your grant items through your school office.
